President's Report (Kristine Frohman):

Thank you sponsors for all that you do for our league!

All division assignments and meet schedules are available on the MCSL web site.

Some housekeeping notes:

- At the April meeting (Zoom) we will do division signups. The "division job signup form" is available online now (https://www.emailmeform.com/builder/form/V5yHGb63Q3o0pM3JSZEeFYm). This form must be submitted no later than the April meeting.
- The May meeting will be in person in Rockville at 8:00 p.m. You will receive ribbons, handbooks, etc. at that meeting. Your dues must be paid by or before this meeting.
- There are votes tonight, and this will serve as attendance at this meeting.

Vice President's Report (Jessica Moore):

- Rule proposal 1 will bring CCSDA officials in line with what is required for MCSL officials.
 The board supports this proposed rule.
- Rule proposal 2 was brought forward by an MCSL team to bring MCSL in line with USA Swimming rules that prohibit the use of technical suits by 12 and under swimmers. The board is neutral on this proposal.
- These will be voted on later in the meeting.
- The transfer window is currently open.

Treasurer's report (Rebecca Fayed):

- There are increases in several budget lines.

- Awards are our biggest expense line. We are returning to baseline after some unusual years due to Covid leftovers.
- Projected income doesn't quite cover all expenses, but we have money in the bank for this.
- Annual dues have been increased from \$400 to \$450 in the budget. This is the first increase in many years.
- We are looking for additional advertising revenue.
- Splash fees for 2023 CLC and AS meets will go out next week based on the previously stated fees.
- We will raise splash fees for the 2025 swim season for the CLC and AS meets. These will not be applied retroactively.

Voting on Proposed Rules (Scott Witkin):

- 83 teams voting
- Vote to approve budget (passed)
- Vote to approve rule proposal 1 (passed)
- Vote to approve rule proposal 2 (passed)

Awards have been ordered. Please make sure someone is present at the May meeting to pick up awards. Remember that dues must be paid in order to receive ribbons, awards, etc.
